This month we have been able to meet and teach several children, teenagers, and adults in our feeding program. We encouraged them to pray every day and set time to

Rene and Norilyn are neighbors and friends of our sister in Christ, Digna. She told us that the couple wanted to have a Bible study with us. As we studied with them, we found out that they have been living together for years with two children, but not yet married. After teaching them the power of the gospel of Christ for the forgiveness of their sins, we also taught them about biblical marriage and how their present relationship would affect their salvation. They understood what God wanted them to do with their relationship, and we offered our help to get them married. We did marriage counseling, and we assisted

them in any way we can to get them married. We thank God so much for they finally got married on April 28. They decided to be baptized for the cleansing of their sins on the very first Sunday of this month right after the church services.

Joy Daroya, Mary Joy Daroya, and Michaela Constantino are cousins and high school students. They



were part of the group of the young people that we met when we visited their grandmother who is a member of the church and did a feeding program in their place last month. At first, we met to study only once a week, but we made it twice a week in the following weeks as our schedules permitted us. understood that Christ died for them for their eternal life in heaven, they decided to obey the gospel in baptism for their salvation.
